

Vinyl Graphic application instructions



Step 1. Clean the surface.

Use a dry cloth to clean the surface. Soapy water is best. If using a degreaser, follow up with soapy water to remove any chemical film.



Step 3. Tape in place.

Once you are satisfied with the position, apply another piece of tape across the top of the vinyl graphic. Half the tap on the premask transfer paper and half on the application surface. Rub tape firmly to ensure good adhesion to both surfaces.



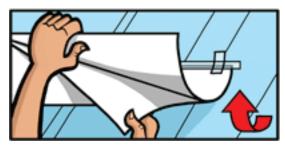
Step 5. Apply the graphic.

Once the backing paper is removed, bring the transfer paper forward, keeping taught and using the squeegee, apply pressure from the center to the left then the right in a sweeping motion from the hinge point towards your hand holding the transfer paper.



Step 2. Secure with tape. Tape the vinyl graphic in place and measure from

multiple vantage points to ensure that it is positioned symmetrically.



Step 4. Remove backing paper. With the tape functioning as a hinge, flip the vinyl graphic over and carefully remove the backing paper from the transfer tape. Do this slowly to ensure the vinyl separates from the premask transfer paper



Step 6. Remove Transfer tape. Remove the tape from the top of the graphic. Now carefully peel away the transfer tape, a 45 degree angle is ideal. Do this slowly to ensure the vinyl is adhering to the surface
